We were quite worried how we were going to resolve this issue, as it became more and more pressing. In a show of extreme kindness and generosity, Nelson and Susan Schmitz (our resident Andrew's parents), donated their 2007 Toyota Prius to the Trail House program on February 13th. It was a heartfelt gift, just before Valentine's Day!
